2026 Australia Day Regatta

The 2026 Australia Day Regatta marked the 190th running of this prestigious event, which is recognised as the oldest continual sailing regatta in the world, having started in 1837. This year's regatta featured a fleet of seven boats and was held under overcast skies, with moderate south to south-easterly winds and a choppy sea state and these challenging conditions tested the skills of all participants throughout the day.
